Short and Sweet... and Structured

Mastery of language has two aspects – accuracy and fluency. In this workshop we will play around with a series of short, simple, generative and flexible classroom activities that focus on the first of these with reference to the controlled practice of grammar, vocabulary, and pronunciation. There will be an emphasis on ease of preparation and use.

Short and Sweet... and Serendipitous

In this second workshop we will shift our focus from accuracy to fluency. Once more, we will look at a number of classroom activities, but this time they will be more open-ended and unpredictable in terms of the language they produce. And once again the emphasis will be on activities that are suited to a range of levels, ages, and situations and on ease of preparing and using the activities.
